RE: BEGINNING OF TERM I, 2022 CIRCULAR

Christian greetings from the Hilton family in Jesus Christ's mighty name.

We are grateful to God for keeping us safe and secure during the prolonged lockdown caused by Covid-19 pandemic.

We also thank you so much our dear esteemed parents for the parental care, guidance and providence to our dear children.

Following the directive from Government to have all school re-open for all classes, I am pleased to inform you that we shall report on **Sunday 09th January, 2022** from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm.

PROMOTION

As directed by the Ministry all continuing classes will have automatic promotion to the next classes. This however means that the academic work for 2021 must be covered in 2022 as well. Therefore the learners should be prepared for that extra task.

SCHOOL FEES

Despite the challenges faced by private institutions, our fees remains unchanged. We encourage you to clear fees using the school pay codes that were given to you or visit any branch of Centenary bank/Agent and use Account No: **3100015083**.

S.4/S.6 (2022) students who had paid fees for the special term shall be required to pay 700,000/= as top up for 2022 term's fees.

S.3 (2022) students who had cleared the fees to zero balance are fully covered as per the Ministry directive but those who had fees balances should clear to zero before reporting.

S.2 (2022) will be required to pay a top up of 600,000/= for term I, 2022. However all the previous balance should be paid to NIL.

VISITATION: Until we are guided by the Ministry of Education and Sport and the Ministry of Health, no visitation will be allowed this Term. We therefore request all parents to provide enough personal effects and requirements to the students as they report.

Please kindly take note of the following:-

- a) All students above 18 years should present evident of vaccination against Covid -19.
- b) All learners must report dressed in school uniform.
- c) All hair must be trimmed to 3mm in the usual fashion and style.
- d) The senior two students reporting to S.3 should select their optional subjects with their parents before reporting for term I, 2022.
- e) Every student should report with 10,000/= for 4 (four) customised face masks.
- f) All students should report with a ream of photocopying papers (Double A), a litre of sanitizer, harpic and a scrubbing brush
- g) All candidate class students shall pay Registration fee for National Examinations after the guidance of UNEB by the end of term one. However they must report with 2 photocopies of their birth certificate and then 2 photocopies of PLE results slip (S.4), 2 photocopies of UCE result slip (S.6) which are mandatory for registration.

In conclusion, many children have been exposed to a number of non-academic challenges during the prolonged lockdown. We appeal to you dear parents to pray, counsel and guide them during the remaining period to focus on the forthcoming academic programme come 2022.

We wish you and our children God's blessings during the festive season.
